### GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

*Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.*

**“Every Class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current United States Equestrian rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.”**

**LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES PROVIDED THE RESPECTIVE BREED/DISCIPLINE DUES OR BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE HAS BEEN PAID. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES 7)NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISIONS AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.**

#### USEF Federation Entry Agreement

*By entering a Federation licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees, and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the rules. I*

represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, The Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, or other likenesses of me and/or my horse taken during the competition for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the Competition, sport, or Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including the claim to any compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State.

#### **EXHIBITORS AND OWNERS PLEASE NOTE:**

Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to , or arising out of the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All items not covered in these rules and information shall be decided by Horse Show Management, its decision to be final.

**Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason. A dotted line may be put into effect at management's discretion.**

**The Kentucky National Horse Show and/or EquiShow Inc., its management, officers, owners, officials, and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an owner, exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal, vehicle, or equipment at the show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW AND/OR SHOW GROUNDS. In addition, The Kentucky National Horse Show, or it's parent organization, EquiShow Inc., reserves the right to use any photo, video , or visual/audio record of any type made on the grounds before, during , or after the horse show for any purpose whatsoever, including advertising.**

**STABLING:** Permanent stalls of wood construction, with doors, are available Monday September 14, 2009. Early arrival is only possible by prior arrangement with show management, AND WILL BE BILLED AT \$50/NIGHT. HORSE STAYING OVER UNTIL MONDAY MORNING SEPTEMBER 21 MUST SECURE PERMISSION

**IN ADVANCE AND PAY THE AMOUNT OF \$50 PER NIGHT.** Temporary stalls (vinyl/steel) are available after the supply of permanent stalls is exhausted. **STALLS MAY BE RESERVED BY ADVANCE PAYMENT ONLY.** Cost is \$200 per stall. FEI secured area stalls are \$250 per stall. See FEI information in Open Jumper section for details.

**FEED & BEDDING:** No initial bedding is provided. To order in advance contact Don Devers at 859.233.9702.

**ENTRIES:** Entries close September 1, 2009. New Entries (e.g. new or different horses) made after this date will pay a one time late fee of \$25. There are no scratch/add fees . Every horse on the grounds must be entered and shown in at least one class, or be subject to a non-showing fee of \$75, at management's discretion. **Attention foreign exhibitors:** Entries MUST be paid in "US Funds" and drawn on US banks. **WE DO NOT ACCEPT CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS. Foreign exhibitors who cannot pay in US Funds will have their entry and stall costs calculated at the current exchange rate PLUS A FOREIGN COLLECTION FEE OF 23%.** Stall and nomination fees must be paid with entries. Numbers cannot be issued to competitors until all credentials have been presented and a signed open check has been presented to the show secretary.

**POLING:** Manual Poling and the use of Bamboo Offsets are prohibited at all times at the Kentucky Horse Park . In the event of a violation of this regulation, the involved horse, owner, rider, and trainer of record will be suspended from further competition at the show .

**JUMP ORDER:** A rotating jump order will be posted for all classes over fences. Riders or trainers with conflicts must be in contact with the starters in a timely manner so that the necessary adjustments can be made. Starters have the authority to scratch entries who make no attempt to be timely, without going through the Steward or Show manager.

**REFUNDS:** Stall fees cannot be refunded after September 1, 2008. Nomination and entry fees cannot be refunded after same date without a vet certificate regarding horse injury or a doctor's note regarding rider injury/illness. Proper notification of all scratches must be made in the show office prior to the start of the class. **Horses which are scratched after September 1 and do not appear at the show will pay a \$50 global fee and forfeit their stall fee. In**

**the event of inclement weather or other emergency, class refunds will not be given to scratched horses. In the event of cancelled classes, refunds will not be given, but every effort will be made to reschedule or restructure the class or division.**

**PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money won will be paid by check or deducted from each horses account. An IRS W-9 Form must be completed in full before any prize money exceeding \$600. will be paid by the horse show. **Please note, all monies won in the YOUNG JUMPER CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE PAID DIRECTLY FROM THAT ENTITY AND ARE NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THIS HORSE SHOW.**

**CHAMPIONSHIPS:** A champion and reserve title will be awarded according to current USEF rules in each HUNTER division, unless otherwise noted. **Jumper championships will be awarded only in the following divisions: Childrens, Adults, Low Jr/AO, High Jr/AO, and Pony Jumpers.** There will be no bonus points classes for Show Championships. **IN THE EVENT OF A TIE FOR CHAMPION OR RESERVE IN ANY JUMPER DIVISION, SAID TIE WILL BE BROKEN BY THE SHOW CHAIRMAN. DUPLICATE PRIZES WILL NOT BE AWARDED.**

**PROPER ATTIRE/ PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** All riders must wear protective headgear at all times while jumping, anywhere, anytime on the showgrounds. Headgear must meet ASTM Standards and be properly secured by a harness.

**DAY HAULERS:** There is a \$20 grounds fee for horses that haul in to show , in addition to the KHP trailer day pass fee. HORSES WHICH HAUL IN TO SCHOOL OR BE SHOWN TO PROSPECTIVE BUYERS MUST PAY THE \$75 NON-SHOW FEE IF THEY ARE NOT ENTERED AND SHOWN IN AT LEAST ONE CLASS.

**CAMPER SPACES:** Available at the Kentucky Horse Park Campground adjacent to the showgrounds. ***Phone reservations: 800.370.6416 or email Christy Combs at ccombs@kyhorsepark.com*** This horse show DOES NOT reserve any group spaces through the horse show office.

**PARKING:** KHP parking passes may be obtained upon entry at the Parking Booth or Visitor Information Center. \$5 per vehicle per event. The Park requires all competitors showing out of their trailer to purchase a trailer day pass for \$25 per day or \$75 per season. All trailers must park in approved lot. No Parking is

allowed in the barn area. Horse Trailers must be dropped in the KHP Parking lot, NOT in the stabling area. Horse Trailers with living quarters must go to the campground.

**COGGINS TEST:** Kentucky law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative Coggins Test certificate dated within one year. **PLEASE ATTACH A COPY OF YOUR HORSES COGGINS TO YOUR ENTRY.** Horses traveling from out of state must also be accompanied by a valid health certificate, dated within 30 days. ***KENTUCKY HORSES ARE NOW REQUIRED TO HAVE A HEALTH CERTIFICATE DATED WITHIN 150 DAYS.*** This paperwork should accompany the horse at all times.

**RINGS/FOOTING:** The Walnut Ring, Outdoor Main Stadium, and Stonelea Ring are all Fine Sand and Synthetic Fibre on pvc mats (OTTO SPORT). Footing in all other outdoor rings and warmup areas is a sand/limestone mix. The indoor arena footing is a sand cushion on a limestone base. Indoor Arena is 145'x 285' . Outdoor rings are a minimum of 150'x250'. Main Outdoor stadium is 121,000 sq ft; Walnut Ring is 85,000 sq ft, both irregularly shaped.

**SCHOOLING:** Weather permitting, hunter rings will be open for schooling on the day prior to the show. Jumping will be permitted only when medical personnel are on the grounds.

**WARNING!** Horses that compete in a class in which they are not properly entered will be charged a double entry fee. Once a horse has competed in the first class of an AA Rated Hunter Section, the division entry fee is fully earned and cannot be refunded.

**GLOBAL & NIGHT WATCH FEES:** Each showing and non-showing horse will be charged a global fee of \$50 . This fee covers show and stable office services, admission to the exhibitor supper, 2 tickets to the world cup qualifying class, and Night Watch Service provided by Robert Murphy Horse Watch. All Non-Showing and YJF horses are required to pay the global fee.

**DIRECTIONS TO SHOWGROUNDS:** From I-75 north of Lexington, Ky, exit #120 (Iron Works Pike/ Kentucky Horse Park). Follow signs to the park and “event stabling”. **Be prepared to pay for your event parking pass and present Coggins and Health Certificates upon entry to the Park.**

**IMPORTANT HORSE PARK RULES**

\*BARN AISLES/ENDS – No parking allowed.  
Unloading/loading only in these areas.

\*No camper hookups to the barns at any time.

\*Show ground passes – must be purchased at gate. \$5 per event

\*Golf Carts/Mopeds – a privilege, NOT A RIGHT, extended to show participants. Must be at least 16 years of age to operate. Not allowed in visitor areas of the Horse Park. Exhibitors wishing to bring their private carts must purchase a golf cart license from Devers. \$25 per show or \$50 per season.

\* **No 4 wheelers are allowed**

\*DOGS – must always be on a leash or suitably restrained. Loose animals will be removed from the grounds at owner’s expense.

\***HORSES AND HORSE DRAWN VEHICLES – have the right of way at all times**

\*All non emergency problems/special requests must be relayed through show management

\*Packages/Deliveries – The park is not responsible for any deliveries to an event or event participant; or vendors on the grounds..

\*Park Admission – reduced price park admission is available and must be obtained at the Visitor Information Center. Proof of participation may be required at the point of sale.

\*per Ky fire codes, KHP no longer allows 2 prong electrical appliances or cords or any adaptors without 3 prong connections.

**FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY:** The financially responsible party for The Kentucky National is EquiShow Inc., a Tennessee Corporation. The independent contractor providing horse night watch services is Robert Murphy Jr. Horse Watch. Most vendors on the grounds are operating as independent contractors and are under the direction and control of the Kentucky Horse Park, not the Horse Show.
