INFORMATION AND GENERAL RULES

This show is a regular member show of the United States Equestrian Federation. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing, Dressage, Reining and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 non-member fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) leadline 2) exhibitions 3) games and races 4) classes for 4-H members 5) walk/trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program) 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes 7) NRHA endorsed reining competitions 8) Opportunity classes 9) Citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation 10) USEA beginner novice division and 11) assistant handlers in Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ENTRIES: Entries close September 1 and should be postmarked by that date in order to avoid late fees. New Entries made after this date will be charged a one time late fee of \$25 per horse. late or "on time". Entry blanks must be completed, signed, and accompanied by an open check in order for numbers to be issued. Current Coggins certificates should accompany each horse. **STABLING FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE STALLS WILL BE ASSIGNED.**

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: All fees must be paid in "US Funds" with checks drawn on a US Bank. **WE DO NOT ACCEPT DEBIT/CREDIT CARDS.**

OFFICE/ADM FEES: All horses, showing and non-showing, will be charged an office fee of \$35 per show week in addition to their stall or day hauler fee.

DAY HAULERS: Only allowed with prior permission from show management. There will be a day hauler fee for this privilege.

STALLS: Stalls are \$200 BASE PRICE. If you request VIP Stabling and are assigned to that location there will be an additional per stall charge of \$50 for VIP and \$75 for Elite... Stalls are of permanent and/or temporary construction, with doors; 11'x11'. Hay and bedding will be for sale on the show grounds. **BEDDING CAN BE PRE-ORDERED BY CALLING THE SHOW ORGANIZER AT 615.838.7560. STALL FEES MUST BE PRE-PAID IN ORDER FOR STALLS**

TO BE RESERVED; this may be done by sending an official entry form "or" via the stall reservation form ALONG WITH STALL PAYMENT.

NON-NEGOTIABLE PAYMENTS: Exhibitors who issue non-negotiable checks to the horse show will be charged an additional \$100 for each time the check is returned by the bank; AND PROMPTLY REPORTED TO THE USEF FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION. In addition, EquiShow Inc. reserves the right to bar from future competitions any competitors that have issued bad checks on previous occasions.

REFUND POLICY: Until September 1, 2010, all stall and entry fees are fully refundable if proper notice is given to show organizer (email, fax, or call). After September 1 stall fees are, in general, not refundable unless show organizer grants a special exception. Entry fee refunds will be decided on a case by case basis; but in general entry fees are not refundable unless special circumstances can be shown.

USEF FEES: All Exhibitors are required to pay the \$15 Usef Drug/Adm fee; plus a \$2 per horse USHJA Zone Support fee. Non-Members of USEF or USHJA will be required to pay a non-member fee in order to participate.

SCHOOLING/ATTIRE/HEADGEAR: Jumping will be permitted only when medical personnel are present on the grounds. Protective headgear must be worn by all riders whenever mounted. Headgear for all riders must meet ASTM standards, carry the SEI Tag; and be properly secured by a harness. Hunter Rings will be available for schooling the day prior to the shows. Schooling schedule to be posted outside of show office.

DOGS: Dogs MUST BE ON A LEASH AND UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. Owners of Dogs that disrupt a competitors round will be required to pay the affected horses entry fee in said class. Dog owners failing to comply with USEF rule 301.6 may be subject to penalty and/or warning cards issued.

ARENAS: All arenas are at least 250' by 150' with a limestone base and sand footing.

FEED AND BEDDING: Can be ordered through the show office. Initial bedding can be ordered via the stall reservation form or by contacting the show organizer at 615.838.7560.

MOTORHOMES & RV's: A limited number of RV hookups will be available at \$300. Please call 615.838.7560 by SEPTEMBER 1 to reserve! Hookup fees are non-refundable.

JUMP ORDER: A rotating jump order will be established for all classes over fences. Starters have the authority to scratch entries who are not timely.

COURSES: Will be posted at least 30 minutes prior to each class. At management's discretion a dottedline may be put into effect to restrict the size of the courtesy circle in hunter classes.

POLING: Manual poling and the use of bamboo offsets is prohibited at all times on the show grounds.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money won will be credited to each horses account and the balance owed paid upon checkout. All Owners of horses winning over \$600 MUST PROVIDE PROPER TAX ID NUMBERS AND COMPLETE AN IRS W-9.

PHOTO AND VIDEO RIGHTS: It shall be a condition of entry to these shows that show management may utilize any photo or video of any exhibitor or their horse shot during the competition for any purpose whatsoever, including , but not limited to: advertising, websites, or results publication.

SCHEDULE CHANGES: Show management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes; make course alterations and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

Show Licencee: The USEF Licensee for this show is EquiShow Inc., a Tennessee corporation.

Attention: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent, guardian, and or trainers from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6 of the USEF Rules. Wheelchair and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Directions to show grounds:

From Chicago: I-90 (Kennedy Expressway) West to Rt 59 (Barrington,IL) / Rt 59 South to Stearns Rd (West Bartlett, IL) / Stearns Rd West (right turn) to end (Dunham Rd) / Left turn onto Dunham Rd / 1/8 mile Lamplight is on the right

From St. Charles Hotels: Rt 64 East (MainSt/North Ave) to Kirk Rd North. Kirk Rd turns into Dunham Rd. Continue North. Lamplight is on the left appx. 1.5 miles after Army Trail Rd.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Courses to simulate fences found in the hunting field, such as: brush, wall, aiken, coop, gate, and rails. Classes to be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. A dotted line may be put in the course . Eight Ribbons will be awarded in all Hunter classes. In each section a Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded based on points. Hunter prize money will be distributed to the top 6 horses (unless otherwise stated) as follows: 30% 22% 15% 13% 10% 10%.

In Order to participate in Zone 5 Finals classes, the owner or lessee of the horse must reside in Zone 5 and said horse/pony must be entered and complete the course in at least one class of the corresponding division at this show. Zone Finals Winners receive Zone recognition , ribbons, and a prize. Section Fees do not include the entry fee for the cooresponding Zone 5 Finals class.

Entries in "AA" divisions must pay the entire section fee; individual classes may not be entered. Please note : hunter classes designated as "HANDY" courses will be so noted on the show schedule of classes.

Sponsored by the USHJA Zone 5 Committee, the purpose of this class is to recognize not only young horsemen who reside in zone 5 and ride well, but also reward those who understand the great importance of quality horse care.

This class is a 3 phase equitation class, open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and reside in Zone 5. The over fences phase (50%) will consist of a course of at least 10 fences at 3'6 maximum height. A combination will be included. Water or a liverpool will NOT be included. The flat phase (25%) will be open to everyone in the class. The written phase is based on George Morris's "Hunter Seat Equitation" , consisting of 25 questions and will be worth 25% of the total score. The time and place of the test will be announced at the competition; and will be at a time and place convenient to all the competitors.

Fabulous Prizes!!!! 2009 prizes included a saddle, bridle, trophy, cooler, halter, shirt, and gift certificates!!!

319 ASPCA/Maclay National Horse Show Regional Championship

A hunt seat equitation class open to Junior members of the ASPCA who have been certified by the National Horse Show as being qualified to compete in the Maclay Regional Championship at the Kentucky at Lamplight horse show.

Entries in this class are requested to **enter directly with the National Horse Show using the special entry blank provided in this prize list. The class entry fee is to be paid directly to the National Horse Show.** Qualified participants must also enter the class through the normal entry procedure, specifying "Class 319" on the entry blank and providing the rider's current ASPCA number.

THE ENTRY BLANK TO SEND TO THE NATIONAL HORSE SHOW IS STAPLED BEHIND THE MAIN ENTRY BLANK IN THIS PRIZE LIST. IF YOU ARE DOWNLOADING ENTRY BLANKS "ON LINE" THERE IS A SEPARATE TAB LABELED "REGIONAL MACLAY ENTRY". STALLS MAY ONLY BE ORDERED USING THE REGULAR SHOW ENTRY BLANK AND STALL RESERVATION FORM.

All contestants are required to show over at least 8 fences not exceeding 3'6 with or without wings. A minimum of ten more than ½ of the riders competing in the Regional, if available, are required to show at the walk, trot, and canter (no more than 24 at a time). To be judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of the horse. The under saddle performance of those riders selected to show under saddle shall count 50%. Only one rider per horse. USEF tests 1-19. Course to be posted 1 hour prior to the class.

The top ribbon winners, in proportion to the other Regionals, will be qualified for the Finals.

JUMPER DIVISION

All horses competing at Meter 1.20 and above pay a nominating fee of \$175 , including all entries in the Young Jumper Championships. Horses tied for other than first place will be placed on 1st round time. Champion and Reserve Awards will be awarded based on points in the following divisions: Pony, Low Child/Adult, Children's, Adult Amateur, Low Jr/AO, and High Jr/AO. Unless otherwise stated, prize money will be distributed as follows to the top 6 or 8 horses in each jumper class (or 20% of total starters):

\$500 class: \$150/110/80/60/50/50

\$1000 class: \$ 300/200/150/100/90/85/75

\$1500 class: \$ 450/300/200/175/150/125/100
